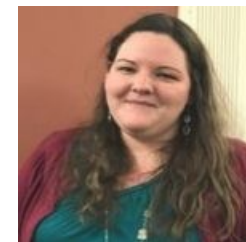

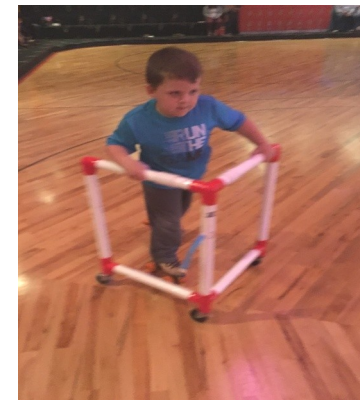
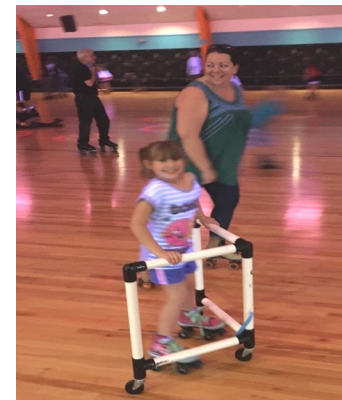


**Children's Ministry Events...**
